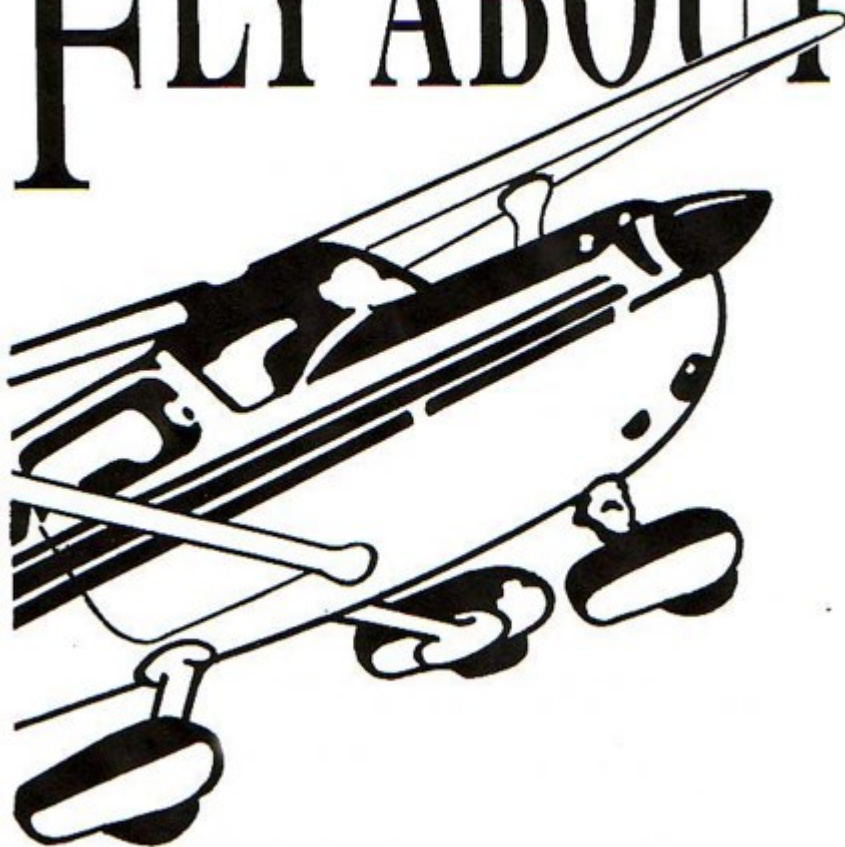

Hi all Members.

In this issue of Fly About we have included the calendar for the National Ballooning Championship Northam. The more volunteers the aero club can supply the more money we can make for the club. Where we cannot supply volunteers we will be letting other interested parties cater for those functions. If you look at the 4.00am or 5.00am briefing breakfast we will require about 3 persons in the kitchen per day. After the competition the main breakfast is held and will require around 5 persons per day. The nightly bar event will only require 2 persons per evening. That equates to about 10 volunteers per day over the five weekdays giving a total of 50 volunteers from the Northam Aero Club. We have approximately 120 Members and you would think filling this quota would not be a problem but from my experience I can see it may be. Club Captains Report

9 a.m. Sunday 10th May saw Northan Aero Club conduct the Monthly Flying Comp from Northam Airfield.

All Pilots were sent full Comp details 30 days prior including all radio calls/tracks/landmarks etc.

A short cross country mini air trial was the Comp.

A really Great day for our Monthly Flying Comp.

Wind a light Easterly at 5 knots, so Runway 14.

Because it was Mother's Day some of our pilots had to put in an Apology, but the die-hards were there with their Mums.

We dedicated this Mother's Day Comp to our Mums of course.

So - In briefing room at 9 am all pilots placed their Nominated Time for the Flying Comp., in a sealed envelope, to be opened by the Judges with all pilots present at Debrief session. Each pilot nominated his own time from wheels off to wheels on.

Tasking was to take off and depart overhead tracking 300 degrees for a pool/reservoir 2 n.m. East of Toodyay, identify old airstrip, then track southerly for Toodyay Racetrack, and from there track 130 degrees for Spencer's Brook, then track for Northam Airfield.

Pilots took some of the Mothers for a local flight for MOTHER'S DAY, which was enjoyed by all.

Six Pilots and five different aircraft took part in this Comp.

All pilots will receive full details as per usual next couple of days: tracks, Radio Calls etc. in full.

So print it off and practice flying the next Comp in next 30 days, as good a reason as any to fly more eh?

Club Aircraft is available at all times, just remember there are some duty's that need to be performed when you have finished with it:

1. Clean the bugs of the leading edges, windscreen etc.
2. Leave the interior neat and tidy, take your rubbish with you.
3. Pitot cover needs to be on, and keys put back in the usual place.
4. Report all maintenance issues to the Matt Bignell on 0407873700.
5. If you use the last of the oil contact Matt Bignell to order more.

Some people travel a very long way to fly the club aircraft and it would be very disappointing to arrive and find it US.

Please leave the aircraft as you would like to find it.

DATE PUDDING WITH CARAMEL SAUCE.

1 ¼ CUPS PITTED DATES
1 CUP WATER
1 TEASPOON BI-CARB.
60 GRAMS BUTTER,MELTED

2 EGGS – BEATEN
2/3 CUP CASTOR SUGAR
1 ½ CUPS S R FLOUR
1 TEASPOON VANILLA ESSENCE

PUT DATES IN MEDIUM SAUCEPAN WITH WATER AND SIMMER GENTLY UNTIL THEY FORM A THICK PASTE.

BEAT IN BI CARB OF SODA AND BUTTER, THEN GRADUALLY ADD EGGS AND SUGAR. FOLD IN FLOUR AND VANILLA.

SPOON MIXTURE INTO GREASED LOAF PAN AND BAKE IN MODERATELY HOT (190C) OVEN FOR 25 MINUTES.

CARAMEL SAUCE

2/3 CUP BROWN SUGAR
2/3 CUP CREAM
60G BUTTER
½ TEASPOON VANILLA

PLACE INGREDIENTS IN SMALL SAUCEPAN, BRING GENTLY TO BOIL, THEN SIMMER FOR 5 MINUTES..... SPOON OVER PUDDING.

National Ballooning Championship Calendar

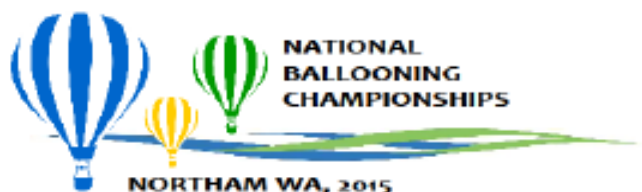
