

Dawn Raid on the Northam Aero Club

On Sunday, the 9th of October, pilots from the Royal Aero Club Jandakot flew into the Northam Aerodrome for the annual 'Dawn Raid' flying event.

Fortunately, they were expected and were in time for a hearty breakfast, then comparing of notes and a briefing session for the flying to come.

Six pilots attended to compete against the Northam Aero Club's six pilots.

Flying activity was based around safe and proficient airmanship with sound procedures, starting off with standard take-off Runway 14, and circuit, then precision delivery of a simulated engine out event from over the start of Runway 14 at 1,000ft above ground and a consequent safe glide approach on a left circuit for Runway 14 with a safe landing in all cases.

Competing pilots were to land on the "Piano Keys" white paint markings at the beginning of Runway 14 proper.

Two pilots achieved this, thus gaining maximum points and winning the competition for their respective clubs being Rob Garnaut for the Royals and Peter Hill for Northam.

The competition was organised by the Club Vice-President and Captain Errol Croft and judged by Dennis Beresford, Preston Smith and a member of the Royal Aero Club Jandakot.

The competition was narrowly won by the Northam Aero Club with Peter Hill in his Cessna 152 placing first (in only his second attempt and much to his surprise), second place awarded to Errol Croft, followed closely by Ian Berry.

All pilots displayed good flying skills, although one found he needed to bring his engine back to life to make the strip, which cost some points, but the main thing is all arrived safely.

The Northam Aero Club welcomed many new faces at the 'Dawn Raid' with spectators partaking in the delicious cooked breakfast and some even taking up the opportunity of a free flight. Thanks must be extended to Les Ballantyne and his merry band of chefs and the Northam Aero Club committee for organising such an enjoyable morning.

Following on from the Annual Dawn Raid the Royal Aero Club departed 11 am and flew over Avro Anson Rd Mokine Memorial site on their return flight to Jandakot as a mark of respect to four RAAF aircrew whose Anson W2262 crashed and burst into flames there on the 9th October, 1942 at 11:42am (0342 z). This aircraft was out of Pearce for Geraldton after performing D/F exercises.
