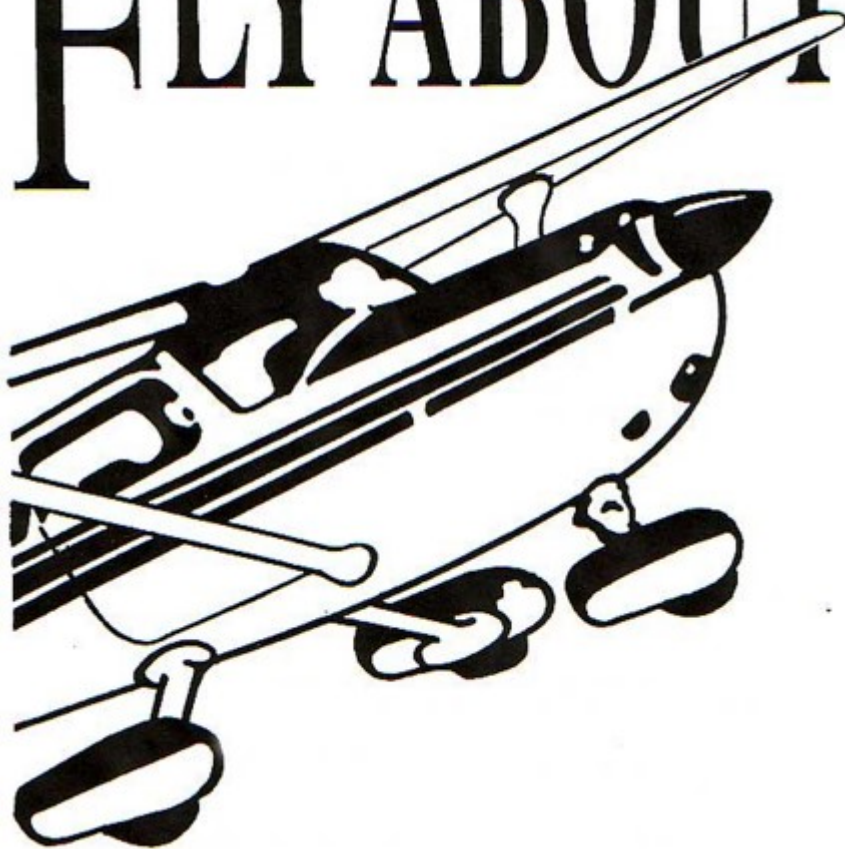

Each Pilot from TEAM NAC was given full details of this Comp including Radio Calls etc 30 days before the actual event, thus giving all Pilots the time and opportunity to understand/prepare and to even FLY a few practice circuits to brush up on their short field skills...

TASKING: Short field take off in less than 300 metres.

Strip inspection on first circuit.

Full stop short field landing on second circuit.

A line of flour 300 metres from start of piano keys marked the available "deck space" for short field ops.

Any Pilot who went past this line before stopping his aircraft was not disqualified but missed out on scoring 10 points towards his score for the day.

All TEAM NAC Pilots flew well and flew safely, Judges were happy!

The wings come from VH-EDJ an ill-fated victim of a poor landing by a C182 at Tooradin Airport in the South East of Victoria. The C182 left the runway shortly after touchdown and crashed into 3 stationary aircraft, writing off all three. Fortunately for us the wings were not damaged in any way.

It was an early morning start to remove the wings, pack them up on a trailer along with the fuselage and make the 300 km journey home.

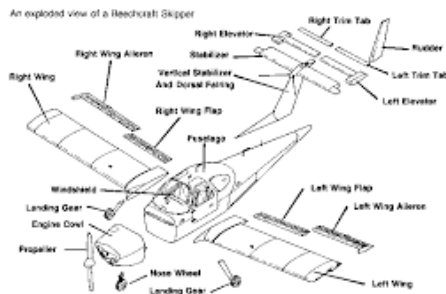

- This Airfield is a No Smoking Airfield. The only smoking area is the brick paved area behind the Clubhouse
- Pets & dogs must remain on a leash at all times
- The Police Helicopter will arrive at 09:00am, and depart at midday. Once the crew have disembarked, you may talk with them and inspect the helicopter. During arrival and departure, remain well clear and beware of the downwash.
- Ladies toilets are alongside the Clubhouse. Gents toilets are behind the Clubhouse
